Tax Changes

How to handle Tax changes in Track

Do Not:



- Update an existing tax
- Remove existing tax from a tax policy while taxes overlap
- Leave a gap between start and end dates



- Create a new tax line
- Set the start date the <u>Same</u> as the end date
- Add it to the policy

- Enter an END date on the tax that will be increasing. If your new tax takes effect Aug 1, 2025- that will be the END date.
- Create a new tax for the increase
- Start Date will be the Same as the End Date

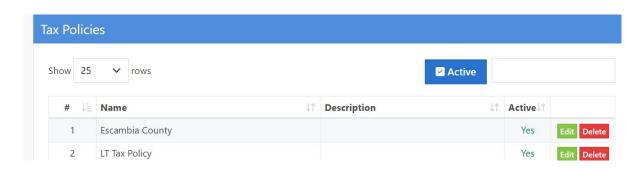

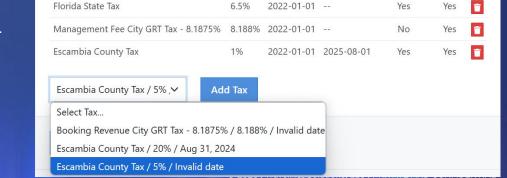

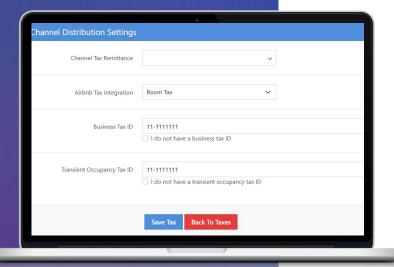
